Competition Details: There will be medals for all top four fencers in each category, plus medals for the best under 18yrs. and best Veterans. Food and drinks will be sold.

Equipment: Leon Paul will be providing an equipment stand for all fencing needs. We recommend pre-ordering your kit if you would like to purchase on the day!

Armoury: Armourers will be available over the weekend if you have any kit problems.

Please Note: All weapons will be fenced electric throughout. Fencers are responsible for providing their own personal equipment. You may only enter one event per day. Fencers should ensure that they have the appropriate and full level of membership of their National Body before the competition and competitors must produce their membership to be inspected during registration. All clothing and equipment must conform to British Fencing regulations. Under plastrons must be worn (specification, minimum 800 N).

Closing Date: For entry into the Wrexham Open 2012 is the 5th June, 2012. Entries must be received on or before 8th June 2012 otherwise they will be classed as a late entry. Please make *all cheques payable to 'Wrexham Fencing Club'* and write the *fencer's name and weapon on the back*.
